

Pre-Entries close **Monday** before each show. (Entry fees, open check or credit card # must accompany pre entries)
NON-NEGOTIABLE OR NSF CHECKS WILL BE CHARGED
AN ADDITIONAL \$40 PLUS ANY COURT COSTS.

FEES: Entries **PAID and RECEIVED** by closing date are \$12/class. Post entry/adds: \$15/class.

Make checks payable to **FAIR HAVEN FARMS LLC**. Enclose a copy of each horses negative coggins test with pre entries. You must show proof of negative coggins before back numbers can be issued.

STALLS:

Permanent stalls are available- \$75.00 for weekend, \$65.00 for overnight, \$50 for day stall. \$10 for day shipper fee.
Shavings are available for \$8/bag. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Weekend stalls have priority ahead of overnight and day stalls. Please call Karen at 412-848-3501 to reserve.
STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED.

REFUNDS:

NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.

Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from a veterinarian. In either case above, the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.00.

SCHOOLING:

Schooling will be permitted in the **main ring** Friday 1pm -7 pm, and until 7:30am the morning of the show. Weather permitting.
No lunging in show ring. Lunging in **designated** areas only.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Proper show attire is requested.

All persons mounted on a horse must wear an ASTM-SEI approved helmet.

There must be 3 in each division at each show to qualify for Series Champion and Reserve.

All **dogs** must be kept on leashes.

Show management has the right to ask that disruptive dogs be removed from show area.

PARKING:

Please be advised that all parking is on grass. Trucks, trailers and cars must park in designated parking areas in the grass field. Please follow signs and directions of the parking staff.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Walk/Walk Equitation: Open to any horse/rider combination. May cross enter into leadline.

Lead Line: Open to any horse/rider combination. May cross enter into walk.

Walk Trot Ground Rails: Open to beginner riders only. To be judged on manners, suitability and ability to guide the mount over a course of four rails on the ground. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control. May cross enter into walk trot cross rails.

Walk Trot Cross Rails: Open to beginner riders only. To be judged on manners, suitability and ability to guide the mount over a course of four cross rails. May cross enter into walk trot ground rails. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control.

Canter Cross Rails: Open to any horse/rider combination. Suitability to count. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control.

Short/Long Stirrup: Open to riders with limited experience. Fence height 18". Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control. May cross enter into Beginner Rider.

Very Green: Open to any horse or pony with limited experience showing. Fences 2'3. Judged on performance and soundness.

Beginner Rider: Open to horses or ponies ridden by Juniors or Amateurs with limited experience. To be judged on performance. Fences 2'. May Cross Enter into Short/long stirrup.

Low Intermediate Rider: Fences 2'3. Open to Junior and Amateurs on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance. may cross enter into Short/Long Stirrup, Beginner Rider, Low Children's/adult, very green.

Intermediate Rider: Fences 2'6. Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged on performance. Juniors may cross enter into Low Intermediate, Low child/Adult, OTTB

OTTB Hunter Division : Open to Thoroughbred horse that has a visible lip tattoo or proper documentation. Fences 2'6. Judged on an even hunting pace, manners and jumping style. Horse in this section can cross into eligible hunter division(s) with fence heights of 2'3", 2'6" or 2'9".

Low MHJA children's/Adult hunter: Open to Juniors or Adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

Children's/Adult Amateur hunter: To be shown by Junior or adult amateurs on horses or ponies Fences 2'9-3'. Spreads not to exceed the fence height.

Special Hunter: Open to any horse rider combination. fences 2'3 or 2'6

Pre-Green : open to any horse in their first three years of showing. Fences 2'9

Open Hunter: Open to any pony, horse/rider combination. Fences 2'6, 2'9 and 3'

Fair Haven Farms Hunter Derby: Open to any rider on a horse or pony. No more than three entries per rider. Each horse/rider combination must show in at least one hunter division at 2'3 and above at this show to be eligible for the derby. To be judged on performance, hunter style, brilliance and handiness. Course will be designed to show horse and rider ability to perform over traditional hunter obstacles such as walls, gates, brush, roll tops, natural obstacles and oxers. May included bending lines, trot fences

and roll backs. The class will be conducted as a two round competition and judged by the open numerical system. The first round will be a hunter style course judged on performance and hunter style. The second round will be a shortened course judged on handiness and brilliance. The class will be run as follows: 2'9 height will go first, then 2'6 followed by 2'3. The top 10 from the first round will return to jump the second (handy) round in reverse order of their scores from the first round, lowest score going first. Scores from both rounds will be combined to determine the winners. Exclusive ribbons go to 8th place with prizes. Fence heights 2'3, 2'6, 2'9. Formal attire is accepted. *Must have at least 8 entries* Entry Fee: \$30.00 pre entry. \$35 post entry. Must declare entry before 12:00 pm day of.

MHJA Equitation Over Fences: Riders 14 & under will jump 2'3-2'6. Riders over 14-17 will jump 2'6-2'9.

UP & Over Challenge Medal: Open to any junior or amateur. Fences will be set at a choice of 2'-2'3 or 2'6. Not restricted to Up & Over members. Although must be a U&O Member to qualify for finals. Must have 3 Exhibitors to fill.

YOUNG HORSE DIVISIONS:

Young Horse in Hand: Open to horses and ponies under the age of 5. classes are judged on Confirmation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a hunter. Horses are to be walked and or jogged before being moved on the line in order of preference. If entries warrant, the classes will be divided into a class for fillies and a class for colts and geldings. Handlers may be suitable juniors, amateurs, or professionals . May cross enter into young horse walk trot and walk trot canter cross rails.

Young Horse X-rails and Young Horse 2' : Open to any horse or pony 5 years old and under. Juniors, amateurs or professionals. Will Be judged upon Confirmation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability. May cross enter into both divisions.

JUMPER DIVISIONS:

Beginner Jumper 2'3:Open to all horses, ponies and riders with very limited experience. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into low jumper

Low Jumper 2'6:Open to all horses, ponies and riders with limited experience. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into beginner jumper or hopeful jumper.

Hopeful Jumper 2'9 : Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Spreads not to exceed fence height. may cross enter into low jumper or training jumper.

Training Jumper 3': Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into hopeful jumper.

Fair Haven Farms Jumper Mini Prix:

The class is open to all Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies. All entries must compete in at least TWO Jumper classes at each show prior to the Jumper Mini Prix. The Fences will be set at a choice of 2'3/2'6/2'9/3' with spreads not to exceed fence heights. The top (8) horses will return for the jump off. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through eighth place.
