CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Walk/Walk Equitation: Open to any horse/rider combination. May cross enter into leadline.

Lead Line: Open to any horse/rider combination. May cross enter into walk.

Walk Trot Ground Rails: Open to beginner riders only. To be judged on manners, suitability and ability to guide the mount over a course of four rails on the ground. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control. May cross enter into walk trot cross rails.

Walk Trot Cross Rails: Open to beginner riders only. To be judged on manners, suitability and ability to guide the mount over a course of four cross rails. May cross enter into walk trot ground rails. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control.

Canter Cross Rails: Open to any horse/rider combination. Suitability to count. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control.

Short/Long Stirrup: Open to riders with limited experience. Short-under age 12. Long-age 12 and over. Entries may be split if numbers allow. Fence height 2'. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control. May cross enter into Beginner Rider.

Pleasure Division: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. To be judged on performance with emphasis on manners and suitability. May be asked to halt and back. Entries in the Hunter Hack class will walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and will then be asked to jump two fences. Height of fences 2'.

Baby Green: Open to any horse or pony with limited experience showing. Fences 2" - 2'3. Judged on performance and soundness.

Beginner Rider: Open to horses or ponies ridden by Juniors or Amateurs with limited experience. To be judged on performance. Fences 2'. May Cross Enter into Short/Long stirrup.

Adult Rider: To be shown by adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Fences 2'-2'3.

Low Intermediate Rider: Open to Junior and Amateurs on horses or ponies. Fences 2'3. To be judged on performance. May cross enter into Short/Long Stirrup, Beginner Rider, Low Children's/adult, Baby Green.

Intermediate Rider: Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Fences 2'6. To be judged on performance. Juniors may cross enter into Low Intermediate, Low child/Adult, OTTB

Children's Hunter Pony Sections are limited to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a Junior Exhibitor not showing over fences exceeding 3' at that show. Ponies to be shown by Junior Exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. Large ponies to jump 2'6. Small and medium ponies to jump 2'. All spreads are not to exceed fence heights. Riders in this division are eligible for Children's Hunter Pony Equitation.

OTTB Hunter Division: Open to Thoroughbred horse that has a visible lip tattoo or proper documentation. Judged on an even hunting pace, manners and jumping style. Horse in this section can cross into eligible hunter division(s) with fence heights of 2'6, 2'9 or 3'.

Low Child/MHJA/WPaPHA Adult Hunter: Open to Juniors or Adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Fences 2'6". Child/Adult Amateur hunter: To be shown by Junior or adult amateurs on horses or ponies Spreads not to exceed the fence height.

Open Hunter: Open to any pony, horse/rider combination. Fences 2'6 or, 2'9.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: Open to any pony, horse/rider combination. Fences 18", 2', 2'3", 2'6"

SPECIAL HUNTER: Open to any pony, horse/rider combination. Fences 2'3"-2'6", 2'9"-3'

Children's Hunter Pony Equitation: Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Same restrictions as the Children's Hunter Pony Division sm/med 2" large 2'6"

MHJA Equitation Over Fences: Riders under age 14 will jump 2'3-2'6. Riders age 14 -17 will jump 2'6-2'9. Do not need to be a member of MHJA

UP & Over Challenge Medal : Open to any junior or amateur. Fences will be set at a choice of 2'-2'3 or 2'6. Not restricted to Up & Over members although one must be an Up & Over member to qualify for finals. Must have 3 Exhibitors for points.

Blue/Red schooling class is a practice class , can be ridden as many times as needed BEFORE your chosen division, and may be limited to 3 trips.

\$100 Fair Haven Farms Hunter Derby: Open to any Junior or Amateur rider on a horse or pony. Fence heights 2', 2'3, 2'6, 2'9. No more than three entries per rider. Each horse/rider combination must show in at least one hunter division at 2' and above at this show to be eligible for the derby. To be judged on performance, hunter style, brilliance and handiness. Course will be designed to show horse and rider ability to perform over traditional hunter obstacles such as walls, gates, brush, roll tops, natural obstacles and oxers. May include bending lines, trot fences and roll backs. The class will be conducted as a two round competition and judged by the open numerical system. The first round will be a hunter style course judged on performance and hunter style. The second round will be a shortened course judged on handiness and brilliance. The class will be run as follows: 2' height will go first, then 2'3, 2'6 and 2'9" The first round of each height will return to jump the second (handy) round in reverse order of their scores from the first round, lowest score going first. Scores from both rounds will be combined to determine the winners. Exclusive ribbons go to 8th place. Formal attire is accepted. *Must have at least 8 entries* Must declare entry before 12:00 pm day of Derby. **1st Place \$50 and Prize , 2nd: \$25. 3rd \$15. 4th:\$10**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PRE ENTRIES: \$17/class, \$40/Fair Haven Farms Hunter Derby.
Must be postmarked by **Monday** before each show. Pre-entries *must* be accompanied by credit card #.

POST ENTRIES AND ADDS: \$20/class, \$45/Fair Haven Farms Hunter Derby.
If postmarked after the Monday before each show, your entries and adds are welcomed.

Provide your credit card number on your entry. You must show proof of negative coggins before back numbers can be issued.

STALLS:

Permanent stalls are available- \$75.00 for weekend (**a horse must show both days to reserve a weekend stall or a \$75 non showing fee will be added per day**), \$65.00 for overnight, \$50 for day stall. \$20 for day shipper fee. **\$75 non showing fee per day**. Shavings are available for \$10/bag. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Weekend stalls have priority ahead of overnight and day stalls. Please call Karen at 412-848-3501 to reserve. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED.**

REFUNDS:

NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from a veterinarian. In either case above, the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.00.

SCHOOLING:

Will be permitted in the main ring **Friday 1pm -7 pm**, and **until 7:30am the morning of the show.** Weather permitting.
No lunging in show rings. Lunging in designated areas only.
\$75 schooling fee for non showing horses per day.

Proper show attire is requested. All persons mounted on a horse must wear an ASTM-SEI approved helmet.

There must be 3 in each division at each show to qualify for Series Champion and Reserve.

All dogs must be kept on leashes. Show management has the right to ask that disruptive dogs be removed from the show area.

PARKING:

Please be advised that all parking is on grass. Trucks, trailers and cars must park in designated parking areas in the grass field. Please follow the signs.

ELECTRICITY:

Fans are allowed at \$15 a weekend. Due to limited capacity **NO crockpots, hot plates or any other electrical appliances.**

DIRECTIONS: **PLEASE READ!!**

From I-79 N: Take exit 113 Turn left onto Rt 208/258 , turn right at Sheetz onto 258 N. Go approx. 1 mile to the first right Blacktown Rd and turn right. In ½ mile turn left onto Lee Rd. Fair Haven Farms will be on the right in one mile.

Traveling from either I-80 E or W, Stay On until I-79 South towards Pittsburgh

From I-79 S: Take exit 113 Turn right onto 208/258 Immediate right at Sheetz onto 258 N. Go approx. 1 mile to the first right Blacktown Rd and turn right. In ½ mile turn left onto Lee Rd. Fair Haven Farms will be on the right in one mile
